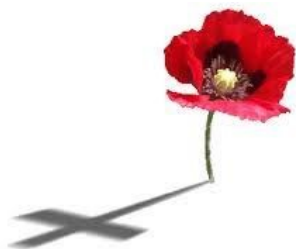

Sabbatical

In simple terms, sabbatical means time off for rest and/or study. The word "sabbatical" comes from the Hebrew word shabbat, which means "to cease or rest." Ely Diocese recommends a three month sabbatical every ten years. I have been in full time ministry since June 2005 and this will be my first. I am adding two weeks annual leave to my sabbatical to visit our son in South Africa. Therefore, I will be away from the 20th November to the 4th of March.

My calling *requires* spiritual vitality. I cannot be a faithful minister *and* remain busy. I must, as the apostles put it, "**devote myself to prayer and the ministry of the Word**" (Acts 6:4). This includes periods of silence and meditation, reflection and prayer, and biblical study—essentially hearing from God. While I have endeavoured to practice this over the past thirteen years, with regular quiet times and occasional retreats, I feel the time is right for me to totally withdraw, evaluate, rest, and draw near to God to be refreshed and gain clear vision for the coming years. I will have retreat time, visit other churches, spend time studying, as well as going on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land.

In my absence, in the legal sense, the two Church Wardens, Nigel and Soli, lead the church. However, with Rachel here as Curate, she has the opportunity to step into the lead role, so with the Wardens blessing and support will do so. They will be supported by the Leadership Team and PCC and all of you: please do pray for them daily.

Whilst I am away, it is my prayer, as in the words of Paul in Philippians 1:27-28, that the church here will, "**conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in the one Spirit, striving together as one for the faith of the gospel, without being frightened in any way by those who oppose you.**" Remain connected to Him as He is our strength at all times.

I will miss you all, and be assured that you will remain very much in my thoughts and prayers.
