Connecting with Jesus, making Him known February 2019



I'm not very good at finding time to keep my houseplants alive, so I don't know if there's much truth in the old wives' tale that speaking to your plants makes them grow faster...although I'm happy for seasoned gardeners to provide me with evidence of their success! But I do know a little about

people - and we certainly need words of life spoken over us - without them, we wither.

James, a leader in the early church, wrote a really practical book about how people should relate to each other, including in times of conflict. Nearly 2000 years ago, he wrote 'the tongue is a small part of the body, but it makes great boasts. Consider what a great forest is set on fire by a small spark.' And about 500 years before that, the author of a book of wisdom called Proverbs advised that 'the tongue has the power of life and death.' Nothing has changed across the millennia.

We don't have much control over the words others say to us, but we always have the choice to speak life to a person in return. You don't know how much difference you may make by speaking kindly, building another person up for a job well done, or telling someone what they mean to you. I believe little choices between family members and neighbours make a difference to communities, which in turn make a difference to whole areas, and who knows, maybe even the whole nation.
