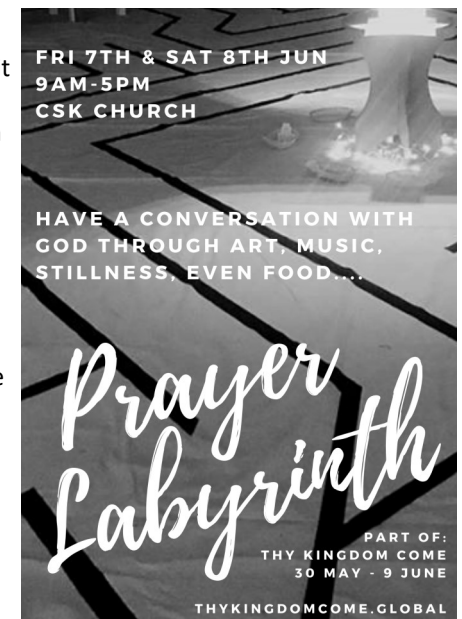

Prayer Gym

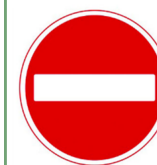
Saturday 8th June, 5 – 5.30pm
