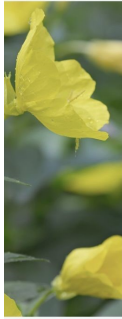

Future Exciting Events

Full-immersion baptism (6th Oct) and Confirmation (17th Nov)

Although these dates may seem far away, they will come round very quickly. Is God calling you to either, or even both?

It was an immense privilege and joy to baptise several members of our congregation in April by full-immersion and so we are once again offering the opportunity in the 10am service, on Harvest Sunday, 6th October. Baptism as an older child or adult also gives you the opportunity to share the difference Jesus is making in your life, with the church and your guests - which was a very powerful moment in our April service.

Meanwhile, we are also looking forward to the Deanery-wide confirmation service, being held at CSK on the afternoon of 17th November, at 3pm with Bishop Stephen. Confirmation marks the point in the Christian journey at which you affirm for yourself the faith into which you have been baptized (often as a child) and your intention to live a life of committed discipleship. This affirmation is confirmed through prayer and the laying on of hands by the bishop. The Church also asks God to give you power through the Holy Spirit to enable you to live in the way of Jesus.

Confirmation marks full membership of the Church of England. FAQs about confirmation can be found here: <https://www.churchofengland.org/life-events/confirmation>. The minimum age requirement for confirmation is 11 years old in Ely Diocese (there is no threshold for baptism).

Please let Sylvia or Rachel know by the end of August (forms are available every Sunday after church), so that classes for both baptism and confirmation can be planned in good time.
