## Connecting with Jesus, making Him known January 2020

These are words that were found in the Bible used by St Teresa of Avila, a nun in the  $16^{th}$  Century, after she died.

'Let nothing disturb you, Nothing frighten you. All things are passing, God never changes! Patient endurance means that all things are possible. Those who belong to God want for nothing. God alone is all-sufficient.'

They're wonderful words and their message is clear: No matter what we walk through in life, we need not be disturbed or afraid. Everything is passing, however awful it may be, and, through it all, God is our rock and anchor. St Teresa's words culminate with hope and absolute certainty: That if we have welcomed God into our lives, God will be our all-in-all – in this life and in eternity.

Well, that's easy to read and even easy to say, but it's not always so easy to put into practice. How can we be *sure* that God will never leave or forsake us, especially during trying and testing times? The best evidence that I can offer you is the *fact* that God cast in his lot with us when He became one of us in and through His Son, Jesus Christ. Becoming one of us gives God a unique insight and understanding of the trials and challenges of the human condition. More than that, God becoming one of us is our *cast iron guarantee* that we need not be disturbed or afraid, even during the bleakest times. In the words of Psalm 46, 'We stand fearless at the cliff-edge of doom, courageous in sea-storm and earth-quake, before the rush and roar of oceans, the tremors that shift mountains' (The Message) – and we do so because God really is unchanging, all-sufficient and always with us.

As we begin this New Year, whatever the future may hold for us, remember that we worship a God who promises to be with us through the calm and joys and through the storms of life.


